### 1. Events

Saturday, November 18th and Sunday, November 19th, 2023 at:  
Jackson Park 708 Glover Street, Hendersonville, NC 28731

All cyclo-cross races are held under USA Cycling Permit # 2023-8175  
USAC rules, regulations and penalties apply.

All amateur USAC races are part of the North Carolina Cyclo-Cross Series (NCCX).

Elite Men's, Elite Women's, Junior Men's (17-18) and Junior Women's (17-18) races are designated and registered as UCI C2 events and are part of the USA Cycling ProCX calendar. A current UCI license is **REQUIRED** for Elite Men and Elite Women, Junior Men's and Junior Women's racers require a valid USAC license and a UCI Id (10 digit number). UCI Regulations and penalties shall apply to these races.

### 2. Registration

Pre-registration is **REQUIRED** for all UCI level category racers, for all amateur USAC category racers pre-registration is highly recommended (save money). Pre-registration is on BikeReg.com.

Registration and rider check-in is located at Shelter #3. All racers UCI and USAC **MUST** check-in both days.

No UCI Elite and UCI Junior 17-18 onsite registration.

### 3. Race Numbers

The **same race numbers** will be used both days. Please ensure your helmet timing chip is properly fixed to your race helmet (do not bend or fold the chip). Race numbers must be placed on the left hip visible for officials and scoring. UCI racers will also receive shoulder numbers. Race numbers must be collected at registration.

#### 5. Equipment

No flat bars or tires wider than 33mm allowed in UCI Elite events. In USAC events tires wider than 33mm are allowed. Mountain bikes are allowed in Junior 9-18, CX4 and Novice categories.

#### 6. Pit Requirements

Each UCI rider will be issued up to 2 pit passes with their corresponding rider numbers at sign-in. All credentials MUST be displayed for race staff and officials to check in the pit and any individual found without proper credentials will be asked to leave the pit area. 3 powered pressure washers will be available for UCI races on-site in the pit area.

In USAC category races, common sense will be the rule. The pit official will have full authority to deny access to anyone interfering or hindering operations in the pit. Spectators are not allowed to view the race from inside the pit.

#### 7. Lapped Riders

Please be courteous and move to the side when being lapped, do not contest or interfere. The Chief Referee can and will pull lapped riders, but it is our intent to allow all riders to finish each event. For the Men's and Women's UCI events, the 80% rule may be applied at the President's discretion.

### 7. **LAPPED RIDERS (continued)**

Early bell option for USAC events & the UCI Junior Women's and Men's races:

- Lapped riders will be left in the race but are not to interfere with the leaders on course.
- Some riders may see the cards change from 3-to-go to 1-to-go and will get the bell before the leaders on the course.
- Riders caught by riders who got the bell will finish when the lap cards display 0 laps-to-go. □
- Riders are placed by time if on the same lap as the leaders, or "@ Laps Incomplete" if they do not complete the full race distance.
- Riders abandoning will be listed as DNF in the results.

### 8. **First Aid/Emergency Services**

An ambulance with medical staff will be stationed near registration.

The nearest hospital is Pardee Hospital located at 800 N. Justice St. Hendersonville, NC 28791

### 9. **Results**

Results will be posted next to the podium and submitted to USAC. Lap times can be found on Webscorer.com.

### 10. **Awards/Podium**

UCI top 3 podiums will take place directly after the race at the Finish Line area. Payouts will be available after the protest period at the podium/awards area at shelter #2.

USAC awards for morning races will be held at 11:50am at shelter #2 next to registration. Top 3 racers will be recognized.

### 11. **UCI Team Parking**

UCI Elite team parking will be located behind ballfield #8 in the parking lot. Please reserve team parking on BikeReg.com Assigned spots will be marked for teams. Please park efficiently and courteously.

### 12. **Collegiate Team Parking**

Collegiate team parking will be located in the parking lot above ballfield #3. Please contact race director for Arrangements. 828 674-9782

### 13. **Overnight Parking/Camping**

Please contact the race director for approval for limited no hookups overnight parking. 828 674-9782.

### 14. **Parking**

Please enter Jackson Park via Glover St. The majority of parking is accessed from the entrance of Glover St. There will be no thru traffic from the 4th Ave. entrance. Parking is very limited from the 4th Ave. entrance.

### 15. **Start Area, Staging and Rider Call Ups**

Riders must be present in the start/staging area no less than 15 minutes prior to the start for staging and call ups.

Riders will be lined up in rows of 8. Please wait in staging before entering start grid.

UCI Elite and UCI Jr 17-18 racers will be called up/staged based on UCI point standings. Riders without UCI points will be ordered by random draw.

Riders must pre-register in order to be eligible for call ups.

USAC staging and callups will be based on Race Predictor (first 3 rows), then order of on start list.

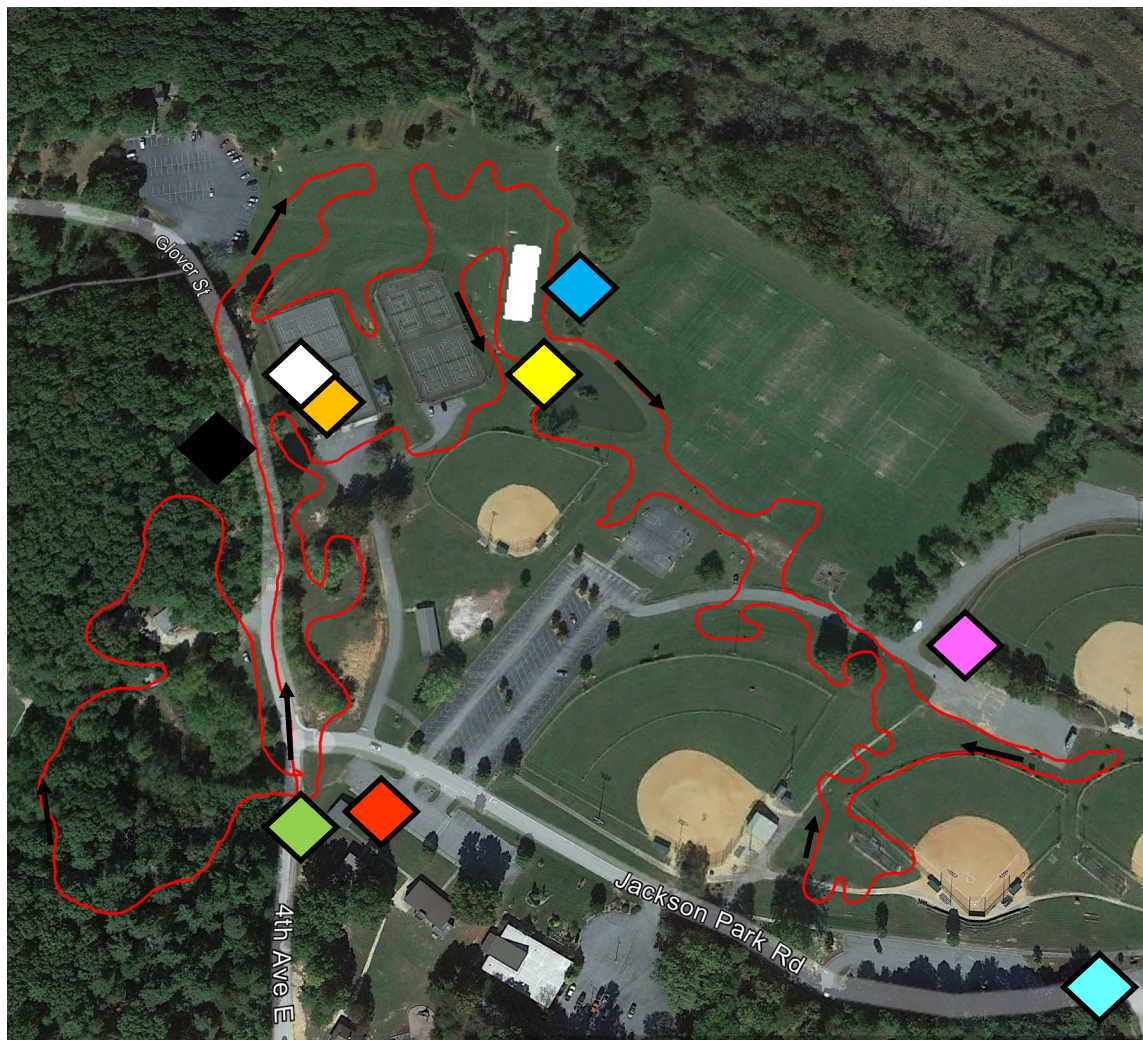

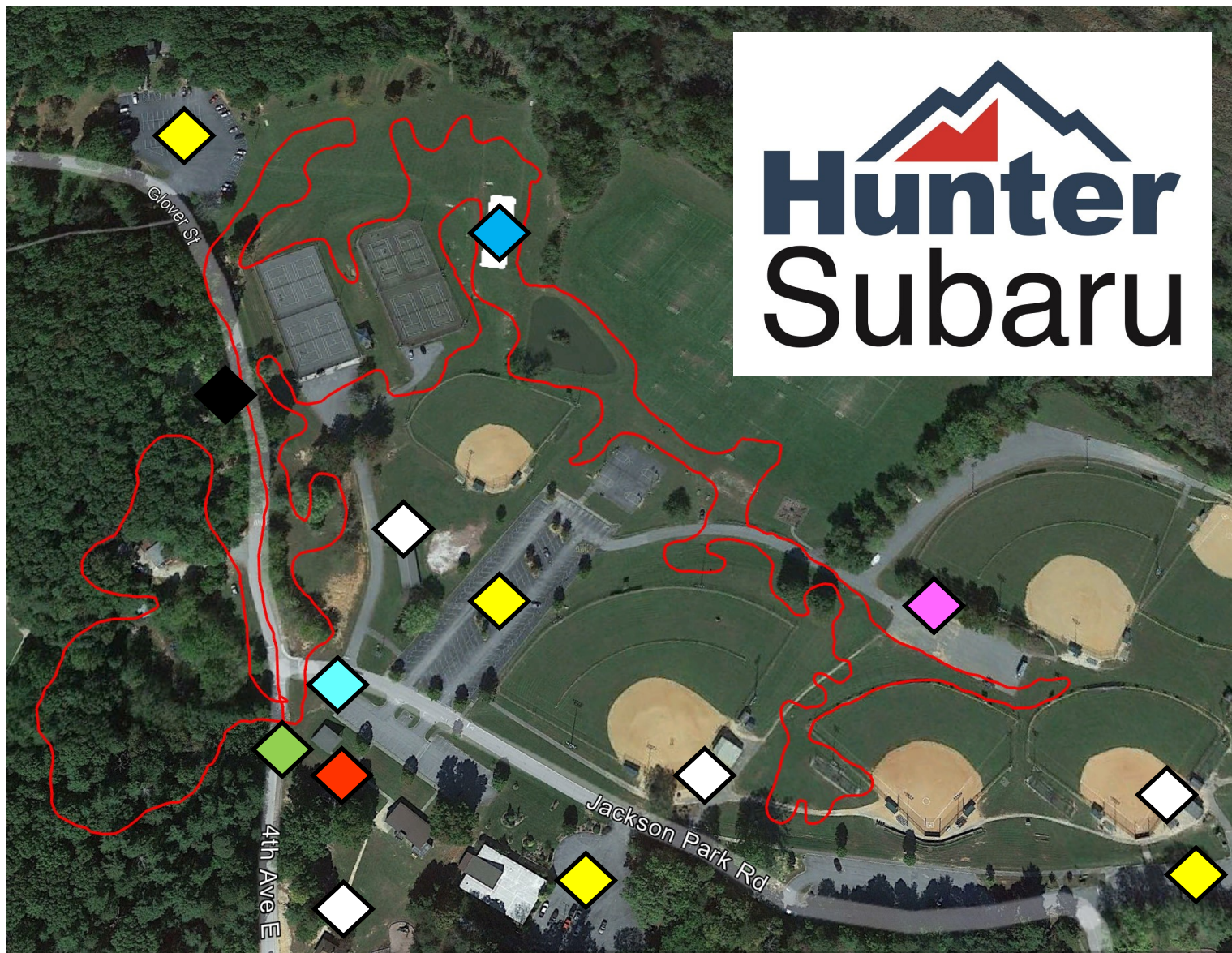
